We accept rolling admissions for this award year-round, but nominations must be received by September 15, 2008 to be considered for the 2008 award.
- 2) All nominees will be contacted by the Committee and asked to submit a teaching portfolio by Sept. 30 illustrating their strengths in multicultural education.
- 3) All nominees will be invited to attend the 11<sup>th</sup> annual Promising Practices conference at Rhode Island College on November 1, 2008 where award recipients will be announced.
