## **COGE REPORT 29 MARCH 2019**

COGE held one brief meeting on Tuesday, March 26, at 1 PM in Clarke Science 116 to consider the following proposals:

- 1. HIST 108 History of Science and Medicine (H) April Kiser
- 2. HIST 274 History of the Dominican Republic (C) David Espinosa
- 3. TECH 306 Automation and Control Systems (AQSR) Charlie McLaughlin
- 4. Assign BIOL 112 to the NS category. BIOL 111 is an NS course. BIOL 112, which has a BIOL 111 prerequisite, was not considered as an AQSR because the course that transfers from CCRI as BIOL 112 (BIOL 1001) does not have a prerequisite. This system leaves CCRI transfer students in the situation of having taken a natural science course but not having met the Rhode Island College NS requirement. Making BIOL 112 an NS course will have little effect on students who take the course here, but will smooth transfer paths for students coming from CCRI (a currently important topic.)

All were approved.

COGE reports that we are continuing cooperation with CCRI about transferability of their courses to RIC. One related proposal is slated for April. A more complete report will be submitted in April.
