Comments: A request to approve a new course for the Youth Development program YDEV 300 Introduction to Youth Development. This has been tried out as a topics course and would like to become a permanent fixture in the program. This will raise the total credit by 4 (to 69-83). While the upper end is high, this is unlikely to ever occur, but given the potential choices it could be possible so needs listing. Most students take YDEV 413 to satisfy their Non-Profit Certificate which reduces that top number by 4, most will take the required minor at far less than the maximum 28 credits, and other courses can double count as General Education.
