The First-Year Writing Award at Rhode Island College Rules and Entry Form for Academic Year 2017-2018

The First-Year Writing Award at Rhode Island College is designed to celebrate the writing produced by students enrolled in First-Year Writing (FYW). It is awarded by the FYW Program. **Cash** prize(s) will be presented to award recipients.

Information and Guidelines

Eligibility

All RIC students enrolled in any sections of FYW 010, FYW 100/H/P between May 15, 2017 and May 12, 2018 (inclusive). This includes Summer Sessions I & II and the fall 2017/spring 2018 semesters.

Submissions (see reverse side/next page for entry form)

- 1. Any writing or semester project completed for FYW 010/FYW 100/H/P within the eligibility framework outlined above.
- 2. Submissions must be students' own work, with citations and acknowledgements given when appropriate.
- 3. No more than two (2) separate entries accepted from any one student or group of students. If the work is collaborative, students must supply written permission from all collaborators with entry form.
- 4. Submissions must include name of student and instructor, course and section number, and date. This information will be removed prior to judging.
- 5. Students should submit clean copies (i.e., free of instructor comments or revision marks).

Judging and Permissions

- 1. Judging will be done during the summer immediately following the eligibility period. Winners will be announced and awarded in the fall.
- 2. The English Department's Composition Committee, chaired by the Director of Writing, will judge the submissions. If the number of submissions warrants additional judges, those judges will be selected by the Director of Writing. The judges' decision is final.
- 3. Award-winning essays/projects will be posted on the FYW Program website (http://www.ric.edu/firstyearwriting/). Award recipients may be asked to present their entries during Writing Week; award-winning essays/projects may, at some future point, be published in a FYW Program booklet. The applicant's signature on the entry form indicates permission for the above. Regardless of the judges' decision, applicants retain all rights over their own submissions.
