ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- * Must be a declared major or minor in Portuguese active and in good standing
- * Must be at minimum a sophomore
- * Minimum GPA: 3.0

PREFERRED:

- * Completion (or demonstrated plan to complete) a Research Methods course in any social sciences subject.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE STUDENT INTERN:

- * Reports to the Director of IPLWS
- * Assists in general office operations
- * Assists with Institute's advancement, research and cultural projects and associated events

COMPENSATION:

- * Will receive a \$500 stipend upon completion of 33 hours' work averaging approx. 2-4 hours per week (\$15/hr), renewable upon review and student availability.
