And
Rhode Island College



Whereas, the University of the Azores and Rhode Island College recognize the value of educational, cultural and scientific exchange between higher educational institutions; and

Whereas, the University of the Azores and Rhode Island College work in areas of mutual interest;

Therefore, we agree to develop cooperative academic projects in areas of mutual interest and (pending available funds);

To plan specific programs which will result in the exchange of faculty, staff and both graduate and undergraduate students, and


To promote the exchange of bibliographic information, publications, data, and research materials in fields of mutual interest and

To make facilities and equipment of each institution available to researchers from the other institution, and

To seek joint funding from foundations and other sources as may be appropriate to further these objectives and

We further agree that specific agreement concerning areas of interest to both institutions may be considered under the general framework of this accord, and that this accord is entered into for no set period and it is our intent to establish ongoing cooperative relations. Notwithstanding this intent, however, either party may, with ninety (90) days written notice terminate this agreement.
