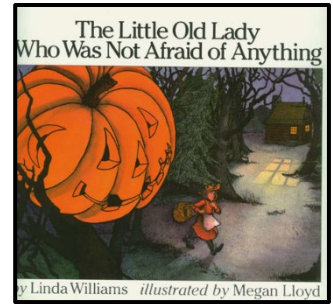





Book Title: The Little Old Lady Who Was Not Afraid of Anything

Grade Level: PK-2

Brief Plot Synopsis: The little old lady walks through the woods only to encounter some strange things. She remains brave and faces her fears.



Object to Be Used	What part/page of the story does it apply to?	What are possible learning objectives? Visual skills, auditory skills, motor skills, communication skills, academic skills
<p>-shoes -pants -shirt -gloves -hat -pumpkin</p>  	<p>Each time a new object appears in the woods.</p>	<p><u>Motor/Academic:</u> Student can reach for/feel each object as it appears. Student can one at a time place the objects where they belong to create a scarecrow. (Child sized clothing can be used for easier manipulation).</p> <p><u>Auditory:</u> Student can listen to the clapping of the gloves, stomping of the shoes, and the “boo” of the pumpkin.</p> <p><u>Communication:</u> Student can make the noises of the various objects i.e., “swish-swish” for the shirt.</p>
<p>Scarecrow</p> 	<p>When the little old lady makes a scarecrow out of the items</p>	<p><u>Motor:</u> Student can assemble the scarecrow or reach for/feel it.</p>
