The Sherlock Center, located at Rhode Island College, is seeking individuals to serve as survey interviewers for the National Core Indicators Survey.

The purpose of the NCI survey is to accumulate data that will help measure and improve the quality of supports for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. The survey is done once a year and will be conducted both remotely and in-person. This is a temporary position between the months of January and June, 2024.
