Comments: A request to update the NMT program to accommodate changes in the licensing requirements. Three CTSC courses will be added (#087), the one credit RADT 440 will be deleted from the program, and NMT 432 will be reduced from 7 to 5.5 credits (#088) to lessen the raise in credit total for the program. This will be raised from 79 to 82.5. Three NMT courses will be offered at a different time to accommodate the new CTSC courses into the sequence (#089 and #090) and #091 asks to remove the NMT 432 prerequisite for CTSC courses and replace it with the more flexible: "Acceptance into a Medical Imaging Clinical Program" as students taking CTSC courses, either may not need NMT courses, or may need to take the courses concurrently. #094 is to replace the outgoing MATH 181 prerequisite for RADT 201 with an alternative MATH course.
