Comments: A variety of Anthropology proposals: some are sorting out the old catalog listings where several courses were entered under a single heading (something the new CMS could not handle effectively). These courses have been separated out and each given their own entry (#022, #025, #026 and #027). Also,

some new courses that speak to the current strengths of the faculty are being requested: (#021) ANTH 214 Peoples and Cultures of Amazonia; (#023) ANTH 312 Archaeology of Mesopotamia and South Asia; (#028) ANTH 330 Language Endangerment and Linguistic Revitalization—while three more for which they no longer have the faculty to teach will be deleted ([#024] ANTH 313 Regional Studies in Archaeology – Europe, [#024] ANTH 319 Regional Studies in Cultural Anthropology – Africa, and [#029] ANTH 418 Cultural Pluralism). There is also a request to add a credit hour to ANTH 208 (#020) to allow for a greater writing/research component and to bring it in line with the department's other four credit courses.
