- Applications are only reviewed once they are completed (including all transcripts and recommendations)
- Applicants should expect to hear of their application decision on or around April 15th.
- Please do not call the School of Social Work to find out the disposition of your application. All decisions will be provided in writing.
- Admissions decisions are final. We do not have an appeals process.

2) Letters of Reference:

- You can check online to see if your letter of reference writers have submitted your letter. If they have not, you can send them reminders via your online account
- Letters of reference can only be submitted online (mailed, faxed or emailed letters of reference will not be accepted)
- If your letter of reference writer is having issues with the CollegeNET link and/or if you need to make any changes to the writer's information (ie, new email address); please contact CollegeNET directly for assistance via your online application or at lor help@collegenet.com

3) Incomplete Applications:
